**THAT, Aware that** Paragraph twelve (12) of Part two (2) of the Fourth Schedule to the Constitution of Kenya, 2010 devolves the responsibility for firefighting and disaster management to the County Governments,

NOTING THAT the County, and in particular Dadaab sub county has recently experienced fire disasters especially in the Refugees market centers and other unplanned settlements in the county.

**FURTHER NOTING THAT,** such fires cause considerable property damage and immense suffering to citizens,

**DEEPLY CONCERNED THAT** most firefighting equipment such as fire engines and personnel are stationed only at the County Headquarters (thus making it difficult for timely response to fire disasters due to lack of appropriate access roads to ensure efficient movement of the fire-engines whenever the fire disasters happens,

**Now therefore** this Assembly urges the Department of land and Urban Development to deploy one fire fighter and the requisite personnel's to Dadaab Sub County Headquarter, in order to support Dadaab and its environs for timely and effective response.
