Mr. Speaker Sir, I beg to move the following Motion:

That, aware that, article 43 (1) of the constitution provides that every person has the right to the highest attainable standards of health, which includes the right to health care services, including reproductive healthcare.

Further aware that, Health Services including County Health facilities and primary health care have been devolved to the County Governments pursuant to paragraph 2, Part Two of the fourth Schedule to the Constitution;

Concerned that, the attainment of the foregoing objective remains a challenge due to lack of periodic early cancer screening and lack of awareness creation within the level 4 hospitals in the County.

Noting that, while access and use of high—quality and comprehensive health services could prevent or mitigate many chronic illnesses such as cancer, a wide range of barriers including ignorance and uncertainties from accessing these services are witnessed in all the Sub Counties in Garissa County.

Now therefore, this Assembly urges the County Executive Committee Members for Health and Sanitation to establish Periodic Cancer Screening and awareness creation in all the Level 4 Hospitals in the County.
