3.MOTION: ESTABLISHMENT OF AN AD HOC COMMITTEE TO INVESTIGATE ISSUES REGARDING REFUGEES RESIDING OUTSIDE THE GAZETTED AREAS

That Aware That, there are growing concerns regarding refugees residing outside officially designated or gazetted areas, which may lead to challenges in managing resources and ensuring compliance with legal frameworks;

Further Aware That, the presence of refugees outside these areas may impact local communities, strain public resources, and create potential legal and security concerns;

Now therefore, in exercise of its oversight function, this House resolves to establish an Ad Hoc committee to:

1. Investigate the extent and reasons for refugees residing outside the gazetted areas

2. Assess the impact of this on local communities, including pressure on housing, healthcare, education, employment and conflict between the two parties;
3. Review current laws and policies governing the settlement of refugees in gazetted areas and examine any gaps or challenges in enforcement;
4. Engage with relevant stakeholders, including government authorities, local communities, refugee organizations, and other affected parties, to gather information and insights;
5. Provide actionable recommendations to address the issues, ensuring both the protection of refugees' rights and the management of resources in host communities;
6. Submit a comprehensive report with findings and recommendations to the House within 90 days.
