(STATEMENT SOUGHT FROM THE CHAIR COMMITTEE ON LANDS, PHYSICAL PLANNING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT)

Hon. Speaker, the process of land surveying, titling, and town spatial planning currently being undertaken in Dadaab Sub County is a critical step toward enhancing land governance, improving infrastructure, and ensuring orderly urban development. It is expected that such an initiative is conducted transparently, with full accountability and in accordance with legal frameworks and community interests.

Hon. Speaker, However, serious concerns have been raised regarding the conduct of the company contracted to carry out these activities. The company has allegedly allocated to itself a disproportionately large parcel of land through irregular and unprocedural means.

This action not only undermines the integrity of the entire spatial planning and titling exercise but also violates principles of fairness, equity, and public trust.

Hon. Speaker, the misuse of authority by entities entrusted with public responsibilities is absurd and wanting. The Companies, FATCO and Arc-Plan despite being awarded projects worth millions, there has been little or no tangible progress on the ground, casting serious doubt on the firm's capacity and commitment to deliver on public mandates;

Hon Speaker, Public participation and transparency must be central to all land-related initiative. FATCO and Arc-Plan companies have been engaged in consultancy services related to cadastral surveying, registration of land titles, and spatial planning across several sub-counties in Garissa County, including **Hulugho**, **Masalani**, **Dadaab**, **Modogashe**, and others; and yet convincing results are yet to be seen on the ground.

In the statement the chair Lands, physical planning and Urban development should inquire and report in to:

- 1. Whether the department is aware about the said exercise going on in Dadaab Sub-County?
- 2. If yes which company was contracted to the land surveying and planning in Dadaab?
- 3. What criteria was used to select the company responsible for the work?
- 4. What is the progress made by the said company in Hulugho, Masalani and Modogashe in relations to the said matter?
- 5. The amount awarded to FATCO and Arc-Plan Companies in undertaking the said exercise?
