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## FOREWORD

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

On 5th June 2023, the County Assembly of Garissa received a nomination letter from the Governor, pursuant to Section 58A (a, b, c, d, e) of the County Government Act No. 17 of 2012. The letter contained the names of five nominees to be considered for approval by the County Assembly for appointment as members and the chairperson of the selection panel.

The Committee on Appointment was mandated with the task of vetting the nominees to determine their suitability for the positions. On 20th June 2023, the Committee conducted the vetting process. During the vetting, all the nominees appeared before the committee and provided the necessary documentation. The Committee assessed the nominees based on the requirements laid out in Section 58A (a, b, c, d, e) of the County Government Act No. 17 of 2012.

After conducting the vetting, the Committee found that all the nominees had met the requirements laid out in the Act. Additionally, all the nominees scored above the pass mark in the vetting process, indicating their competence and suitability for the position. Therefore, the Committee recommends that the Governor appoints the nominees, Mohamed Khalif Nunde (Chairperson), and Hussein Shakil, Mohamed Nur Duwane, Bashir Abdullahi Odhowa, and Hibo Abdullahi Hussein, as members of the selection panel.

### **1.4 Introduction**

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

Pursuant to Section 58A (1) of the County Government Act, 2012 states that whenever a vacancy arises in a county public service board, the governor shall nominate and, with the approval of the county assembly, appoint members to a selection panel for the purpose of selecting suitable candidates for appointment as members of the county public service board. Further, section 58 (2) states that the selection panel under subsection (1) shall consist of the following persons –

- (a) a chairperson, not being a public officer;
- (b) one person from the private sector;
- (c) an Advocate of the High Court of Kenya, who is a member of the Law Society of Kenya;
- (d) an accountant who is a member of the Institute of Certified Public Accountants of Kenya; and
- (e) one person from an association representing workers.

In line with the above provisions, H. E the Governor, Nathif J.Adam nominated the following person as members and chairperson of the selection panel

According to section 58 (3) requires that the governor shall, in nominating members to the selection panel, ensure that not more than two-thirds of the nominees are of the same gender.however, the committee noted that the nomination by H.E the Governor, Hon.Nathif J. Adam does not fulfil the above provision.

## **1.5 Notification to the County Assembly**

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

In accordance with the provisions of Section 58A of the County Governments Act, 2012, and Section 7 and 8 of the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act, 2017, the Governor vide a letter to the Speaker dated Monday 5<sup>th</sup> June 2023, notified the County Assembly, for consideration and approval, the nomination of members and the chairperson of the selection panel for recruitment for the secretary to the County Public Service Board.

The notification was tabled in the House on Wednesday 7<sup>th</sup> June 2023 and pursuant to Standing Order 42, the Hon. Speaker committed the nominee's names to the Committee on Appointments for vetting.

## 1.6 Notification of the nominees and the Public

The Committee, through the Office of the Clerk, published an advertisement on 13<sup>th</sup> June 2023 in *The Standard* for nationwide circulation notifying the nominee and the general public about the vetting scheduled for 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 in the County Assembly Chambers as indicated bellow

The Committee vetted the nominee on 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 all the nominees, namely Mohamed Khalif Nunde, Hussein Shakil, Mohamed Nur Duwane, Bashir Abdullahi Odhowa, and Hibo Abdullahi Hussein, appeared before the committee and provided the necessary documentation. The Committee assessed the nominees based on the requirements laid out in Section 58A (a, b, c, d, e) of the County Government Act No. 17 of 2012.

## 1.7 Vetting of the Nominees

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

On Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 the Committee held sessions with four members and chairperson of the selection panel nominees. In conducting the vetting exercise, the Committee was guided by, among other documents, the Constitution, the Public Appointments (County Assemblies Approval) Act No. 5 of 2017, the County government Act, 2012 and the County Assembly Standing Orders.

## **1.8 VETTING OF NOMINEES FOR APPOINTMENT TO THE POSITION OF SELECTION PANEL**

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

The Committee examined the nominee using the guidelines provided for in the Public Appointments (County Assembly Approval) Act No. 5 of 2017. The Committee also followed the following criteria in vetting the nominee: -

1. Academic qualifications
2. Employment record and work experience
3. Professional association
4. Potential conflict of interest
5. Suitability to the position
6. Tax compliance
7. Integrity

## **2.0 COMMITTEE PROCEEDINGS: -ORAL SUBMISSIONS**

### **2.1 MOHAMED KHALIF NUNDE, CHAIRPERSON**

Mr. Mohamed Khalif Nunde appeared before the Committee on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 between 0900hrs-0900hrs 16. The nominee took an oath to affirm the details he would divulge to the committee. the Committee having heard his submissions during the meeting, made the following observations on his nomination to the position of chairperson of the selection panel. The nominee also submitted relevant clearance certificates required by article 10 of the Constitution, 2010 such as KRA Compliance Certificate, Good conduct, and HELB Certificate.

#### **2.1.1 Academic Background**

the nominee holds a Bachelor of arts in Education from University of Nairobi (1984), and Diploma in Adult Education from University of Nairobi (1981)

#### **2.1.2 Professional Experience**

the Nominee is currently Chairperson of Garissa County Civil Society Organization, where he advises and promotes human rights and social justice, democracy and governance, and social stability and crime prevention.

Worked as a Consultant at the United Nations Department for Safety and Security (UNDSS), where he collaborated with clients, empowers critical thinking, provides

expert advice, and offers technical guidance. He also worked as the director of Ewaso Ng'iro North Development Authority, where he was in charge of developing and implementing the institute's strategic plan, fostered research excellence, engaged policymakers to influence water-related policies and regulations, and developed educational programs to raise awareness about water-related issues and promote best practices. The nominee also worked as district education officer and as a teacher and head teacher in various primary schools

### **2.1.3 Submissions during committee proceedings**

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

regarding his experience and suitability for the position the nominee informed the committee his experience in private and public sector of more than 50 years and holds bachelor of arts in Education. The nominee informed the committee that he possesses the knowledge and skills required to effectively carry out the role as a chairperson of the Selection Panel. In his submission he informed the committee he also previously served as a member of a similar panel for the recruitment of County Secretary of Garissa.

Regarding the qualification expected of secretary to county public service board the nominee stated some of the qualifications and requirements for the position of Secretary of the County Public Service Board include a Bachelor's degree in Human Resource Management, Public Administration, or any other relevant field, at least five years of experience in a similar role, and should be a certified public secretary

Concerning the criteria, he will be using as the chairperson of the panel to assess the suitability and competence of the applicants for the position of Secretary of the County Public Service Board, the nominee informed the committee he would assess their educational background, relevant work experience, knowledge of public service regulations, and leadership skills. To avoid discrimination, the criteria would be based solely on job-related qualifications and not on personal attributes or beliefs.

To ensure that the recruitment process for the Secretary of the County Public Service Board of Garissa is free from political interference, the nominee assured that he will ensure that the selection panel members are unbiased and independent in their decision-making.

In regards to the process for appointing the Secretary of the County Public Service Board, and how the panel will ensure that the process is followed, the nominee stated advertising the position in national newspapers, shortlisting candidates, conducting interviews, and recommending three successful candidates to Governor for appointment.

Concerning key challenges the chairperson might face in his role as a chairperson The nominee informed the committee that ensuring that the recruitment process is fair, transparent, and free from political interference. To address these challenges, he stated he would ensure that the selection panel members are well-trained and equipped with the knowledge and skills required for the recruitment process.

To ensure that the members of the Selection Panel work effectively as a team and that their decisions are based on consensus and collaboration, the nominee stated he would encourage open communication among the panel members.

To ensure that the recruitment process promotes public confidence in the integrity and professionalism of the County Public Service Board, the nominee confirmed he will ensure that the process is transparent, fair, well-documented and open to public scrutiny.

## **2.2 HUSSAYN SHAKIL JAFFER, MEMBER**

Mr. Hussayn Shakil Jaffer appeared before the Committee on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 between 0930hrs-1000hrs. The nominee took an oath to affirm the details he would divulge to the committee. the Committee having heard his submissions during the meeting, made the following observations on his nomination to the position of member of the selection panel. The nominee also submitted relevant clearance certificates required by article 10 of the Constitution, 2010 such as KRA Compliance Certificate.

### **2.2.1 Academic Background**

the nominee holds diploma in Business administration from Garissa Commercial College (2012-2014), certificate in information and communication technology from Augab Computer College and completed his Secondary and primary education from Imani Schools thika.

### **2.2.2 Professional Experience**

Shakil Hussein worked at Coca-Cola Company Garissa Branch from 2015-2016, where he ensured excellent customer experience, contributed to business targets, gathered feedback from customers, and appraised and addressed customer issues. He was also empowered to make managerial decisions. From 2017 to date, he serves as the CEO of Garissa Merchants General Store, where he oversees the strategic direction of the organization, maintains accountability with the board, manages individual and group performance, and monitors the business environment..Shakil also served as a member the selection panel the recruited the current County Secretary of Garissa government

### **2.2.3 Submission during committee proceeding**

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

The nominee stated as a member representing the private sector, in addition to his academic experience, he possesses a wealth of experience in recruitment processes and have been involved as a member in the selection panel that recruited the current County Secretary.

In responding the According to the qualifications and requirements for the position of Secretary of the County Public Service Board pursuant to the County Government Act, 2023 the nominee stated that the applicants must have a bachelor's degree in a relevant field, a minimum of five years of experience in a senior administrative position, and a thorough understanding of the county's public service system.

Regarding the criteria he would use to assess the suitability and competence of applicants for the position of Secretary would the nominee stated their qualifications, experience, skills, and ability to work collaboratively with others.

To ensure that the recruitment process for the Secretary is free from political interference, the nominee stated he would advocate for transparency and accountability in the process.

According to the County Government Act, 2012, the nominee responded on the process for appointing the Secretary of the County Public Service Board and stated the process involves advertisement of the position, shortlisting of candidates, conducting of interviews, and selection of the most qualified candidate.

To ensure that the recruitment process promotes public confidence in the integrity and professionalism of the County Public Service Board, the nominee stated he will advocate for transparency and accountability in the process.

### **2.3 BASHIR ABDULLAHI ODOWA, MEMBER**

Mr. Bashir Abdullahi odowa appeared before the Committee on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 between 1000hrs-1030hrs. The nominee took an oath to affirm the details he would divulge to the committee. the Committee having heard his submissions during the meeting, made the following observations on his nomination to the position of member of the selection panel. The nominee also submitted relevant clearance certificates required by article 10 of the Constitution, 2010 such as KRA Compliance Certificate, compliance certificate from HELB, Compliance certificate from CRB, Clearance from EACC and receipt confirming police clearance certificate

### **2.3.1 Academic Background**

the nominee holds a master of arts in educational management and administration from Kampala University(2021), Bachelor of education in Early Childhood and Primary Education from Kampala International University(2010), Diploma in Education Management from Kenya Education Management institute(2013).

### **2.3.2 Professional Experience**

the nominee has a wealth of experience in the education sector, both as a teacher and as a unionist representing the interests of teachers in the North Eastern region of Kenya. He served as a teacher unionist at National Executive Council where he advocated for the rights of teachers and helped to improve the education system in the region. He also served as the chairman of the Kenya National Union of Teachers (KNUT) in Garissa branch, where he worked to address various challenges facing teachers, such as low pay and poor working conditions.

### **2.3.3 Submission during committee proceeding**

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

Regarding his experience and relevance to the position, the nominee stated he is a teacher and unionist and has a vast experience in conducting interviews, evaluating candidates, and making fair and objective decisions.

Regarding the qualifications and requirements for the position of Secretary of the County Public Service Board the nominee stated a relevant bachelor's degree, at least five years of work experience, and must be a Kenyan citizen. In addition to the academic and work experience, the nominee stated he will assess the leadership and management skills, communication skills, and integrity to ensure that the criteria are fair, objective, and non-discriminatory.

To ensure that the recruitment process is free from political interference, the nominee reiterated that he will ensure that the process is transparent and that all candidates are evaluated based on their merits and qualifications.

The nominee also responded he process for appointing the Secretary of the County Public Service Board and explained that if approved as a member of selection panel he will ensure the process is followed to the later which includes advertising the position, shortlisting candidates, conducting interviews and recommending the most qualified candidates for nomination by the Governor.

## **2.4 HIBO ABDULLAHI HUSSEIN, MEMBER**

The nominee appeared before the Committee on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 between 1030hrs-1100hrs. The nominee took an oath to affirm the details he would divulge to the committee. The Committee having heard his submissions during the meeting, made the following observations on his nomination to the position of member of the selection panel. The nominee also submitted relevant clearance certificates required by article 10 of the Constitution, 2010 such as KRA Compliance Certificate, compliance certificate from HELB, and Compliance certificate from CRB.

### **2.4.1 Academic Background**

the nominee has a Bachelor of Business Management in Finance & Banking from Garissa University, a Certified Public Accountant (CPA K) certification from KASNEB, and a Diploma in Supplies Management from NES Technical Training Institute. She also completed her Kenya Certificate of Secondary School from Laikipia Girls High School.

### **2.4.2 Professional Experience**

The nominee worked as a Finance Manager at Gold Silver Management, where she was responsible for managing accounts payables & receivables, budgeting, cash flow management, internal controls, payroll administration, auditing, petty cash management, tax & statutory administration, asset management, ledger accounts & reconciliation, record-keeping, and financial reporting. She has also worked as a Mapping Surveyor at Kenya National Bureau of Statistics, where she coordinated mapping areas for conducting surveys and oversaw the work of mapping clerks. Additionally, she worked as an Accountant at Smile World Organization, where she handled accounts payables & receivables and oversaw the overall accounting function of the company. She has also worked as a Bursar at Ummah Primary School.

### **2.4.3. Submission during committee proceeding**

As a nominee representing ICPAK, the nominee stated that she possesses relevant qualifications and experience in finance, accounting and auditing, which would enable her to effectively carry out the role as a member of the selection panel for the recruitment of Secretary to the County Public Service Board.

Regarding the qualifications and requirements for the position of Secretary of the County Public Service Board the nominee stated a degree from a recognized university, knowledge and experience in public affairs, among others. However, she reiterated that upon given the opportunity she will study the requirements as per the County Government Act, 2012

Regarding the criteria she would use to assess the suitability and competence of the applicants for the position of Secretary of the County Public Service Board, the nominee stated if given the opportunity she will assess their academic qualifications, and experience relevant to the position.

To ensure that the recruitment process for the Secretary of the County Public Service Board of Garissa is free from political interference, the nominee stated upon given the opportunity she will ensure that the process is transparent and that all the stakeholders and the general public are involved.

Additionally, the nominee mentioned some of the processes for appointing the Secretary of the County Public Service Board of Garissa such as advertising the position and, interviewing, and selecting the best candidate.

The nominee stated that as a member of ICPAK she will apply her experience to the recruitment process for the Secretary to the County Public Service Board by ensuring that the financial management requirements of the position are met, and that the recruitment process is transparent, fair, and that the best candidate is selected.

## **2.5 MOHAMED NUR DUWANE, MEMBER**

The nominee virtually appeared before the Committee on Tuesday 20<sup>th</sup> June 2023 between 1130hrs-1230hrs. The nominee took an oath to affirm the details he would divulge to the committee. The Committee having heard his submissions during the meeting, made the following observations on his nomination to the position of member of the selection panel. The nominee has not submitted relevant clearance certificates required by article 10 of the Constitution, 2010.

### **2.5.1 Academic Background**

the nominee has academic background in law, having pursued a Bachelor's Degree in Law at Kenyatta University from 2012 to 2016. He subsequently completed his Advocates Training Programme at the Kenya School of Law from January 2017 to December 2017. Mr. Duwane is currently pursuing a Master of Laws degree at the University of Nairobi, where he is focusing on Commercial and International Human Rights Law. Prior to his tertiary education, he attended Alliance High School and Wajir Primary School, where he attained his Kenya Certificate of Secondary Education and Kenya Certificate of Primary Education, respectively.

### **2.5.2 Professional Experience**

the nominee worked for Gulf Energy Limited and Milimani Law Courts' Anti-corruption Department. He started as an intern in the Legal Department of Gulf Energy Limited in 2015 and is currently working there as of 2019. During his internship, his duties included

keeping records of legal documents, drafting Powers of Attorney and Contract Execution Memos, conducting research on continuing corruption cases, acting as a court clerk, and updating legal documents. He was also responsible for reconciling customer demands with the company's various agreements and updating the Legal Department on the latest decided cases in the Kenya Law Reports website. At Milimani Law Courts, he worked in the Anti-corruption Department from May 2014 to July 2014.

### **2.5.3 Submission during committee proceeding**

As an advocate of the High Court, the nominee stated during the oral submissions that he possesses the necessary qualifications and experience to effectively carry out the role as a member of the Selection Panel for the recruitment of Secretary to the County Public Service Board. In his submission, the nominee stated his experience in the legal profession has equipped him with the necessary skills to analyze legal provisions, identify potential legal risks, and provide legal advice to the Selection Panel.

According to the County Government Act, 2012, the qualifications and requirements for the position of Secretary of the County Public Service Board, the nominee stated that the secretary must be a certified public secretary and meets the requirements of Chapter Six of the Constitution of Kenya, 2010. He also mentioned that the secretary must have at least five years' experience and be a Kenyan citizen.

To assess the suitability and competence of the applicants for the position of Secretary of the County Public Service Board, the nominee stated he will check on the education, experience, skills, competencies, and personal qualities of the applicants. To ensure that the criteria are not discriminatory, he stated he will ensure that they are objective, job-related, and in compliance with the County Government Act, 2012. Additionally, he assured that the recruitment process is free from any form of discrimination, including gender, age, ethnicity, and religion. As the legal advisor to the Selection Panel, the nominee stated he would also ensure that the process is in compliance with the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and any other relevant legislation.

To ensure that the recruitment process for the Secretary of the County Public Service Board of Garissa is free from political interference, the nominee stated if given the opportunity he will ensure that the Selection Panel is independent and impartial and in compliance with the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and any other relevant legislation.

According to the County Government Act, 2012, the nominee stated the process for appointing the Secretary of the County Public Service Board of Garissa includes advertising the vacancy, shortlisting of candidates, interviewing the shortlisted candidates, and making recommendations to the Governor for appointment.

Additionally, the nominee assured that the Selection Panel adheres to the timelines and procedures set out in the County Government Act, 2012, and any other relevant legislation. As the legal advisor to the Selection Panel, he assured if given the chance, he will ensure that all legal requirements are met, and that the process is in compliance with the Constitution of Kenya, 2010, and any other relevant legislation.

### **3.0 Committee Findings**

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

The committee deliberated on what would be the pass mark for a nominee to be considered as having qualified for position so nominated and resolved that the pass mark would be average score of 65% or more for both members and chairperson of the selection panel in charge of recruiting the secretary to the County Public Service Board (CASB).

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

The committee having considered the academic and professional qualifications of the nominees, having fulfilled the provisions of section 58A (1) & (2) of the County Government (Amendment) Act, 2012 and attaining the set pass mark of 65% and above are all suitable for appointment as members and the chairperson of the selection panel for the recruitment of the secretary to the County Public Service Board of Garissa.

## **4.0 Committee Recommendations**

**Mr. Speaker sir,**

Following the conclusion of the vetting exercise, the committee makes the following recommendations:

1. That the Assembly adopts the report of the committee on appointment, on the vetting of nominees to the selection panel nominated pursuant to section 58a of the county government act, 2012
2. That the Assembly approves the nomination of Mohamed Khalif Nunde the Chairperson, and Hussein Shakil, Mohamed Nur Duwane, Bashir Abdullahi Odhowa, and Hibo Abdullahi Hussein as members to the selection panel for recruitment of the secretary to County Public Service Board of Garissa.
